MEDICATION SAFETY



WHY IS COORDINATING CARE IMPORTANT?

- A patient may have multiple doctors, and it is important for each doctor to know what medications are being taken
- Always disclose prescriptions, over-the-counter medications, and supplements
- Medications can:
 - Interact with one another
 - Reduce each other's effectiveness
 - Cause harmful side effects when combined

KEEP A CURRENT LIST OF MEDICATIONS, INCLUDING:

- Names
- Dosages
- Frequency (how often you take them)

BEFORE STARTING A NEW MEDICATION, BE SURE TO:

- Ask your doctor if it may interact with any medications you're currently taking
- Ask about potential side effects and what to watch for
- Talk to your pharmacist they are a valuable resource for medication questions

USE ONLINE TOOLS LIKE THE MEDSCAPE DRUG CHECKER TO:

- Check for interactions between your medications, including prescriptions, over-the-counter drugs, and supplements
- Get detailed information on potential side effects, warnings, and safety concerns
- Stay informed so you can ask better questions at your doctor or pharmacy visits
